

Checklist: Thematic analysis

Phase 1: Familiarization with the data

- Did you thoroughly read and re-read your data?
- Did you take initial notes or reflections on the data?

Phase 2: Generating initial codes

- Are all relevant data items coded?
- Did you organize your codes effectively?
- Have you systematically coded meaningful features in the data?

Phase 3: Searching for themes

- Have you grouped related codes into broader themes?
- Did you ensure the themes reflect your research question?

Phase 4: Reviewing themes

- Did you merge, split, or discard any themes that didn't fit?
- Have you reviewed and refined your themes for coherence and relevance?

Phase 5: Defining and naming themes

- Have you defined each theme and clearly described its scope?
- Are the names for your themes clear and representative of the data?

Phase 6: Writing the report

- Is your analysis coherent and transparent?
- Did you link your themes back to the research question?
- Did you provide supporting quotes and interpret them meaningfully?
