

Checklist: Thematic analysis

Phase 1: Familiarization with the data
\square Did you thoroughly read and re-read your data?
$\hfill\Box$ Did you take initial notes or reflections on the data?
Phase 2: Generating initial codes
☐ Are all relevant data items coded?
\square Did you organize your codes effectively?
$\hfill\square$ Have you systematically coded meaningful features in the data?
Phase 3: Searching for themes
\square Have you grouped related codes into broader themes?
$\hfill \Box$ Did you ensure the themes reflect your research question?
Phase 4: Reviewing themes
$\hfill\Box$ Did you merge, split, or discard any themes that didn't fit?
$\hfill\square$ Have you reviewed and refined your themes for coherence and relevance?
Phase 5: Defining and naming themes
\square Have you defined each theme and clearly described its scope?
$\hfill\square$ Are the names for your themes clear and representative of the data?
Phase 6: Writing the report
☐ Is your analysis coherent and transparent?
$\hfill\Box$ Did you link your themes back to the research question?
☐ Did you provide supporting quotes and interpret them meaningfully?
