 - → Direct question
- 2. The professor asked if everyone had completed the assignment
 - → Indirect question
- 3. Can anyone explain the difference between qualitative and quantitative research?
 - → Direct question
- 4. Is it true that the seminar has been postponed until next month?
 - → Direct question
- 5. She inquired whether the library would be open late during finals week
 - → Indirect question
- 6. Did he mention when the research paper is due?
 - → Direct question
- 7. I'm curious about what topics will be covered in tomorrow's lecture
 - → Indirect question
- 8. It would be helpful to know how many pages the essay should be
 - → Indirect question
- 9. What was the main argument of the author's thesis?
 - → Direct question
- 10. Can you tell me what time the library closes?
 - → Direct question
- 11. I wonder if the group meeting is scheduled for tomorrow
 - → Indirect question
- 12. Did she say, "We need to leave now"?
 - → It is placed outside the quotation marks, as the whole sentence is a question
- 13. I can't believe he actually asked, "Will you marry me?"
 - → It is placed inside the quotation marks, as only the quotation is a question
- 14. She asked, "Can you meet at 10 PM?"
 - → It is placed inside the quotation marks, as only the quotation is a question
- 15. What did you mean by (Can you clarify this point)?
 - → It is placed outside the parentheses, as the whole sentence is a question
- 16. I wonder if it's going to rain today (Check the weather forecast)
 - → Indirect question and a statement within the parentheses
- 17. He whispered, "Do you think they heard us?"
 - → It is placed inside the quotation marks, as only the quotation is a question.
- 18. Is it true that she said, "I'll be moving to New York"?
 - → It is placed outside the quotation marks, as the whole sentence is a question
- 19. Can you believe he wondered, "Is this your first time skiing"?
 - → It is placed outside the quotation marks, as the whole sentence is a question



- 20. She couldn't answer the question (What is the capital of France?)
 - → It is placed inside the parentheses, as only the content within is a question
- 21. He asked, "Have you seen my glasses?"
 - → It is placed inside the quotation marks, as only the quotation is a question
- 22. Is it necessary to include a bibliography at the end of every research paper?
 - → Direct question
- 23. How does photosynthesis work in plants?
 - → Direct question
- 24. She asked whether the experiment would require additional resources
 - → Indirect question
- 25. Do you know if the conference is open to undergraduate students?
 - → Direct question
- 26. What impact does global warming have on marine ecosystems?
 - → Direct question
- 27. Can anyone explain why the sky is blue?
 - → Direct question
- 28. The instructor inquired if all students had submitted their essays
 - → Indirect question
